Dear Friends in Christ,

I can hardly believe we are again at the beginning of the Holy Week. I'll be honest Lent is a busy time for Pastors, and yet a great time to reflect on our mortality and a time to consider our current path in life and our faith.

Because as we follow Jesus to the cross and listen to all the eyewitnesses of His life, death, and resurrection, we come to terms with our own faith. Do you have the kind of faith that Jesus talks about, and do you trust that Jesus is walking with you every day of your life and is doing everything He can to guide you in life and to love you unconditionally?

For much of my life, I struggled with knowing that He was there. For the most part, I believed, but I may have been a little shaky on trusting it. So, when I prayed and asked for help, did I trust that the Triune God was working with me and giving me what I needed at the time, or did I somehow just figure it out on my own after racking my brain on it for a week? Faith can be difficult for many of us, especially in grief. I think it's difficult because we must have faith in something we can't physically see. The gospel of John says, so those that believe (or have Faith) in Him will have eternal life. Our Lutheranism completely relies on having faith in God.

The woman with the hemorrhage in the gospel of Mark was pushing her way to the front of the crowd in order to be healed by Jesus. Her trust in Him was amazing. She knew that all she needed to do was get close enough to Him just to touch the hem of his cloak. She pushed and pushed her way to the front, and she knew that this would be her only chance to be healed. Jesus didn't even see her touch Him, but He felt it. He felt the divine power leave his body. When He turned around and asked who had touched Him. The woman came clean and owned up to it. Mark said she came forward in fear and trembling and fell to her knees, and told Jesus why she did what she did. Jesus said, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace and be healed of your disease" (Mark 5:34).

Jairus' (leader of the Synagogue) daughter passed away. And when Jesus got there, He said there was no need to weep. She is only sleeping. The people that were there laughed at Him. So, Jesus asked them to leave the house. He then took the little girl by the hand and said get up. She got up and started to walk around the house. Jesus had told the girl's father "not to fear, but to believe."

Easter is a wonderful time to come to terms with your faith and trust in your Lord Jesus Christ. If you can get to a place where you completely trust in your Lord Jesus, you will be rewarded in this life, and at the same time, you will glorify your Father in heaven.

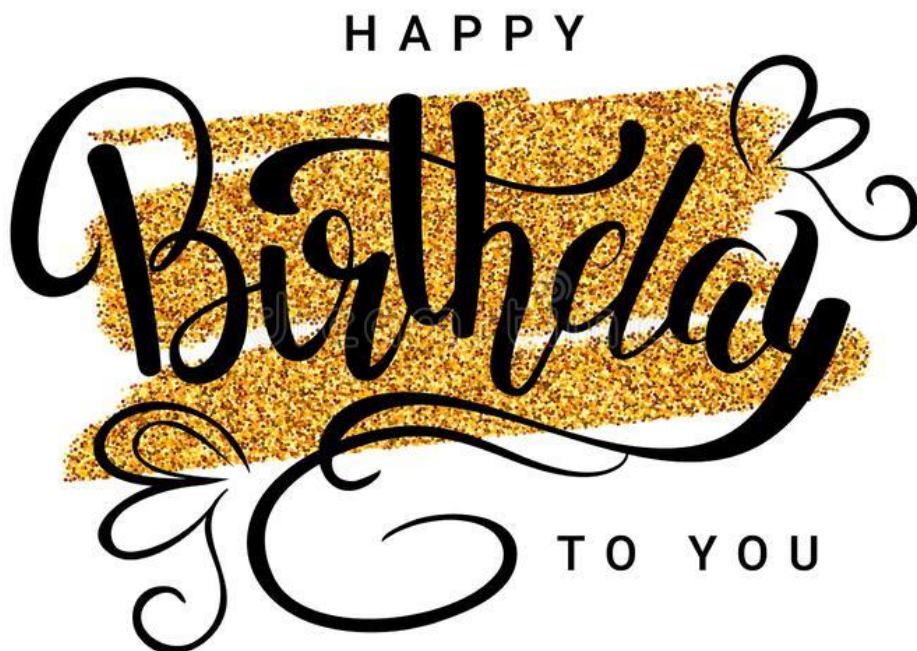
